Family Enrichment Programing

Baby Sign Language - Join us as we explore the basics of communicating with your little one through sign language. Designed just for tiny tots aged 6 to 18 months, this class is a playful exploration of gestures and signs that make understanding each other a joyful experience.



Car Seat Safety Inspections - Proper use of car safety seats helps protect children while in a vehicle. When used correctly, car seats can reduce the risk of death in a collision by as much as 71%. Drive through our inspection line to check to make sure your child's car seat is installed properly and receive car side installations. Community Open Play - Come join us on **Fridays from 1pm-3pm for free open play!** Inside, we have two playrooms where you can engage with your infant, read to your toddler, enjoy crafts, pretend play, explore sensory activities, and more. Outside, there's a playground with water play and scenic walking trails for everyone to enjoy M-F 9am-4pm. We invite all families to come and have fun with us!

Fatherhood Coalition - Join local dads, community partners and professionals to engage in the community conversation about fatherhood. Together, we can shape and strengthen our community. Happy Baby Hour - Bring your little one to share smiles and make friends every 4th Thursday of the month. Enjoy engaging with your infants through sensory play, tummy time while interacting with others to boost their development. Learning through play is so much more fun together - Explore Textures & Sounds through Sensory Ball and Crinkle Book Play

Infant Massage - This series is designed to help you connect with your baby through relaxation techniques, soothing massage strokes, and valuable information about the benefits of infant massage! Anyone important to your baby is encouraged to join in on this special bonding experience.

La Leche League Support - In partnership with La Leche League, we welcome anyone who is pregnant, nursing, hand expressing, exclusively pumping, combination feeding, providing their own milk or donor milk for a child for support and education. Meetings are held in person at our Family Resource Center.



Nurturing Fathers - Nurturing Fathers a 12 week group parenting class for male caregivers with the goal of improving family functioning, facilitating greater communication among family members, and helping to reduce family disruption. Every child deserves a nurturing father - A man who actively provides guidance, love and support to enhance the development and growth of children for whom he cares.

Safe Riders Class - The Safe Riders Program offers child passenger safety education to parents and caregivers in Texas to keep children safe while riding in cars.
